free mobile app allows users to record and archive meaningful conversations anywhere. It provides easy-to-use tools for recording high-quality stories and uploading audio to the Library of Congress and StoryCorps Archive platform.

Recording a Story

The following allow for better recording quality:

- Carpeted floors
- Drop ceilings
- Closed windows and drapes



While using the StoryCorps App:

- Set devices to airplane mode to prevent interruptions.
- Speak slowly and clearly into the microphone from 6" to 10" away.
